

Agriculture accounts for 5.2% of the total employment in Brittany (2.9% in France).

← 69,865 people are employed on farms.




In 2012, 68% of a total of **9.14 billion euros** generated by agriculture (+7% compared to 2011) came from animal production in Brittany.

Turnover of 16.5 billion euros was generated by the processing industry in Brittany in 2011 (11.5% of the industry's national turnover). It increased (+9%) compared to 2010.

The meat industry in Brittany accounts for 46% of total food processing industry turnover in 2011.




